Our curriculum teaches participants who have never been able to skate, at all to the level of competition ready.

Because we are skill-oriented, the Rollerskool class coaches will focus on the developing students based on our proven, robust curriculum.

The benefit of skill-oriented learning lies in the participants' increase in self-confidence in skating, which results in participants being able to skate safely, anywhere.

Rollerskool coaches also understand that not all participants learn at the same pace.

4. Reasonable trainer to student ratio

The key to learning a skill lies in the attention and feedback received by the participants. The Rollerskool team always matches the individual coach's ability and to the participant's potential to optimize the participant's learning process.

As a Rollerskooler, you will be exposed to class standards that are different.

There are several standards that we maintain firmly in every class. Which are:

1. No helmet and safety gear, no skating

"We apologize in advance that if there are participants who are skating without a helmet, they are immediately told to sit."

We do not allow skating without a helmet or protection.

This is simple but extremely important.

"Wearing a helmet and protective gear when learning a new skill has a multitude of benefits when used correctly"

2. Learn to fall and slide with protection

Rollerskool participants will first be introduced how to properly use elbow, knee and wrist protectors.

Training your body to react to falls using protection will reduce the risk of injury. Especially dangerous injuries.

5. Game Based Learning

Every participant in each class will play games. Whether it is looking for treasure, tricking monsters or becoming an airline plane. Participants are invited to play according to their abilities and practice the skills they have learned.



6. Equipment provided

Rollerskool has skating equipment helmets and protectors ready for all participants. We have inventory ready.

For extracurricular classes, we provide equipment (which we are required to provide)

For weekend and holiday classes, the equipment provision is an option.



7. Clear Learning Curriculum

Each Rollerskool class is based on the Rollerskool curriculum learning progression. These skill levels have been tested and proven effective for all ages.



"High fives" is a form of positive reinforcement. The entire Rolleskool class is designed to support participants' efforts. Starting from the coach's language, class mechanics to the closing with stickers. Every aspect of the class is designed to encourage participants to try and be appreciated for their efforts in learning new skills.



6. Periodic Evaluation

A good learning process will be accompanied by a good periodic evaluation process. With the evaluation process, coaches can check the participants' skills mastery. Each Level at Rollerskool has specific learning objectives.



7. Introduction to Competition

The Rollerskool curriculum is designed to enable participants to compete in inline speed, hockey and skate cross. Periodically, the Rollerskool team will hold events to introduce participants to roller skating competitions.

ICP certified instructors are located on almost every continent of the world.



Prospective instructors who take the certification will be tested on theory, inline skating skills and teaching methods.




The ICP program can be taken in English, Indonesian and Spanish.




ICP is a certification that supports the trade and use of inline skates. It stands alone and is independent of the roller sports organizations.

The ICP passing grade is 80% which is high for teaching certifications.



Instructors who have taken the International ICP level 1 certification also receive an i-protect certification.

Under the World Skate organization, Roller Skating has 10 types of sports disciplines that are competed. Of the 10 types of sports disciplines, Rollerskool prioritizes 3 as the foundation of learning. Namely:

Inline Speed Skate - Used to sharpen the strength and speed of participants

Inline Skate Cross - Used to sharpen participant's agility and control

Roller Hockey - Used to sharpen participant's communication and coordination

Using these sports disciplines, Rollerskool builds a sports ecosystem that prioritizes participation before achievement.

There are so many benefits that players obtain from learning to skate. Whether it's just playing, playing to be good at it or playing to compete. By participating, we learn to prioritize the habit before the result.

We see players who focus on good habits benefit throughout their lives.



We also accept that not all Rollerskool participants will be achievement-oriented and competitive. There will be participants who just want to have fun skating with their friends. We make sure there are exciting programs for these participants.


